# Dear Householder

As you know the Council has been working hard to try and reduce the quantity of waste going to landfill – additional recyclables are accepted in blue bins and improved facilities have been provided at the Recycling Centres.

We are encouraged by the support and cooperation of householders but further improvement is needed. Each Council has been given a quota or allowance for waste permitted to be disposed to landfill. This is a European Directive and applies to all Councils.

Last year we disposed of 14,817 tonnes of waste to landfill. Next year we shall only be allowed 11,101 tonnes. Doing nothing to further improve waste diversion would cost £795,224 (fine of £557,400 and landfill tax of £237,824) not counting the operational costs in disposing of the waste to landfill.

This leaflet provides details of how you can help divert waste from landfill by better use of the blue bin system, home composting bins and the Recycling Centres. On the back cover is a calendar for the next year and the contact details of staff that can help if you have any queries – please retain for future reference.

## CONTAMINATION

Contamination ruins the recyclables in your blue bin. The blue bin system must be kept free of food, plastic bags, nappies, and glass otherwise that bin will not be collected. Likewise green bins containing recyclable waste shall not be emptied. If you manage your waste properly, the volume of waste in the blue and green bins should almost be equal.

Care should be taken at the 'bring' sites to have the coloured glass placed in the correct containers – remember take your cardboard boxes and bags home.

At the Recycling Centres, seek help if you are unsure of the range of recyclables accepted and avoid disposal in the "general waste" skip.



## BLUE BIN RECYCLING

SEGREGATE WASTE CAREFULLY

**Material for the Blue Bin should not be 'bagged' but put in loose.**



### YES - PUT IN THE BLUE BIN

#### YES - Newspapers and Magazines

Unshredded office paper, 'glossy' Junk mail. All newspapers, telephone directories, catalogues (Argos etc) 'glossy' circulars. All magazines – Hello, Woman's Weekly, etc.

#### YES - Cardboard

All types of corrugated cardboard and coloured cardboard boxes e.g. burger, cereal, washing powder, toy, toothpaste, dishwasher/washing powder tablets boxes, etc. Note – 'flatten' all boxes. Remove any plastic "windows" and wrapping



#### YES - Plastic Bottles

Coke/Fanta, milk containers, shampoo bottles, Lenor bottles, toiletries bottles, bleach bottles, shower gel, plastic spray bottles, butter/margarine tubs, fruit trays, plastic flower trays/pot, plastic yoghurt tubs etc. (all screw cap plastic bottles) Note – loosen caps.



#### YES - Steel/Tin/Aluminium Cans

(food & drink type), aerosol cans (must be empty) Bean/pea tins, dog food tins, fruit ,meat, Coke, Fanta and other tins, drinks cans (Beer/Guinness), biscuit tins etc.



#### YES - Tetra Pak

Fruit juice/milk cartons

## ADDITIONAL GREEN BINS

**It is Council Policy that extra green bins shall not be emptied.** Only in exceptional circumstances and with prior Council approval shall an extra bin be emptied.



## NO - DO NOT PUT IN THE BLUE BIN

**No** - Shredded Office paper\*, envelopes, paper bags, paper towels, wallpaper, junk mail with plastic covering, hard backed directories



**NO** - Pringle type cardboard containers



**NO** - Plastic bags or soft covers/ wrappings, polystyrene trays, polystyrene beads/packaging, plastic sauce tubs, bacon packs, meat trays, cake trays, plastic cups/knives etc.



**NO GLASS\***

**NO NAPPIES**

**NO FOOD**



**NO ALUMINIUM FOIL**

\* Note Glass, Shredded Office Paper, Paint, textiles, Polyesterene packaging, etc. may be recycled at certain 'bring sites' and/or recycling centres (see back panel).

## REPLACEMENT BINS + COMPOSTING BINS

Replacement bins (green & blue) can be purchased at a discounted rate when you bring in your existing bin for recycling. Composting bins with explanatory leaflet, are available at the Council Depot – cost £5 each.

## TIME OF COLLECTION

Bins must be presented at the agreed kerbside location early in advance of collection. Waste collection commences at 7.00am each morning including all public holidays except for two days at Christmas.
